B. Candidate Related Activities since 2023 to be filled out by the Candidate

1. Your main activities for your ITI Centre

I am Secretary General/Director and Board Member of the ITI Centre Republic of Korea.

I have joined our centre in 2018 and since I've worked with the President and the Board in managing the general ITI Korean centre work; organizing off- and on-line meetings and conferences, arranging celebrations and events, participating in national and international events as the representative of ITI KOREA, and supporting our co-hosted festivals and projects.

In February 2023, we participated in 2023 ITI World Congress Fujairah. ITI Korean Centre was chosen for the Best Performance Practice <The Tale of Lady White Fox with Nine Tales> and I directed and re-designed the show to meet the criteria of the Congress and also performed as the White Fox on stage. It was supported by ITI Korean Centre and my theatre company YVUA ARTS.

I also presented the activity report of our centre at the congress.

In March 2023, we hosted World Theatre Day Celebration at Face Museum, and also shared our experiences of the Congress with our members.

In April 2023, I attended International Dance Day Celebration hosted by World Dance Alliance Korea (President Geung-soo Kim, also the member of our managing committee), supported by ITI KOREA.

During May – December 2023, we had short meetings online or offline either at Face Museum or at my studio office to discuss ITI KOREA projects and workshops.

In October-Novermber 2023, we supported our co-hosting festival World Duo Drama Theatre Festival 2023 and I took part in the festival as well with my original production <The Red Cabinet of Kamakgari the Old Hag>. I also sponsored networking party for the international teams — "Poetic Punk" from Belgium and "Black hat" from Mexico, and my theatre company hosted and staged the play by the Mexico team at our studio theatre...

In March 2024, we organized the World Theatre Day Celebration and General Assembly of ITI KOREA at Artist's House in Seoul. After long-term of commitment to ITI KOREA, President Chyrim Choi stepped down on this day and the new President Ara Kim was elected.

Since then, new members and staffs joined ITI KOREA.

As Secretary General/Director and a Board Member, I now focus and engage mainly on international relations and aspects of ITI Korean Centre.

2. Your participation in ITI Committees, Networks, Forums or Working Groups

I am the Secretary General/Director and a Board Member of ITI Korean Centre.

I've been the Head of Social Change Network within our centre and also the Project Manager for Museum Theatre Institute which is part of the ITI/UNESCO Higher Education Network for Performing Arts.

As a stage director for performing arts, I am very much interested in ITI's Artistic Committee – International Stage Director's Network SDN

In 2023 ITI World Congress Fujairah, for some reason SDN was absent and its meeting did not take place. I hope to the meeting of SDN will happen in 2024 Congress and wish to join them. If necessary I am eager to play a role and contribute in re-vitalizing this network.

3. Are there any goals and visions that you have for ITI for 2024 to 2026?

My goals and vision for the term between 2024-2026 are;

- I believe the main drive of ITI should be artists in the field and the focus of ITI events and conferences should primarily about practical ways to promote art and to support artists and art projects more than anything else.
- I aim to actively promote ITI to performing arts field in Korea and in other countries as well to bring in new or young artists who have little knowledge of ITI, and have more of their fresh voices to be heard in ITI events and conference. May it be amateurish or inarticulate or seem insane, I feel that an art institution needs to be open and actively embrace them; that's what art is about!
- Since I am a stage director, I was very much interested in getting involved in one of the ITI's Artistic Committees International Stage Directors Network (SDN). However for some reason during 2023 ITI World Congress this committee wasn't active and held no meetings at all. At this 2024 congress and in upcoming years, I wish to contribute in making this network active and flourish again, strengthening communications among directors and theatre artists.
- I also hope ITI Committees and Networks, Projects extend their boundaries to environmental issues; contribute to promoting protection of nature and animal rights, and take part in art festivals and projects in the world featuring these themes; such as recycling/up-cycling performances and stage designs, KARA animal rights film festivals and exhibitions.
- With innovations of digital and IT technology, performing arts performances today are actively implementing these techs and skills into their productions. It is changing the ways how the audience experience the performing arts. As the world's largest performing arts institute of UNESCO, I feel that ITI should also think about keeping pace with these rapid changes and embrace digital and film artists, and maybe pop cultures. Boundaries are becoming more and more vague between traditional concept of digital, film, and theatre, and I hope this can be taken into consideration.
- As I am the Director/Secretary General of ITI KOREA, I also wish to share our centre's goals with every centres of ITI and make our experiences richer.
- → We have artists actively working in the performing art fields in Korea as staffs and board members who are passionate about promoting art and sharing goals of ITI. With this rich human sources and experience, the Korea Centre is currently aiming to support international projects and festivals focusing on performances in conflict zones, art and artists of disabilities, and cross-cultural and network between different cultures and countries,
- → It also aims to host "ITI World Performing Arts Capital" event, has been continuously in discussion with the DG and ITI GS, and the Ministry of Culture of Korea government and Seoul Metropolitan government. The new president and the board members also hope to hold ITI World Congress again in Korea in the near future.
- As a part of Asia-Pacific Region, I also aim to create more close connections and collaborations with APF centres of ITI, hopefully contributing to helping people and bringing in peace through the promotion of art in Asia.
